LEXUS' COMMITMENT to the ENVIRONMENT



Did you know:

- Lexus is the only luxury manufacturer featuring four hybrid vehicles: LS 600h L, GS 450h, RX 450h and HS 250h.
- In 2005 Lexus introduced the first luxury hybrid and has since sold more than 80,000 hybrid vehicles in the United States.
- Lexus hybrid vehicles are 70% cleaner for smog-forming emissions than the average new car.
- Lexus is using plant-based eco plastics in its interiors. In the new HS 250h, 30% of the interior and cargo area utilizes eco plastics. In fact, 85% of the HS, including the battery, can be recycled at the end of its lifecycle.
- All Lexus manufacturing plants are near zero-landfill which means 98% of waste resulting from manufacturing is recycled, repurposed or used to generate additional energy.

- Through Lexus Hybrid Living and the Lexus Eco Challenge scholarship program, Lexus is committed to advancing environmental stewardship.
- While the RX 350 (gas model) has the highest combined MPG rating in its class, the hybrid RX 450h is estimated to improve on that figure by more than 30 percent.*
- All of Lexus' hybrid vehicles are covered by the standard Lexus warranty. Additionally, the hybrid-related components, including the HV battery, battery-control module, hybrid control module and inverter with converter, are covered for eight years/100,000 miles.


