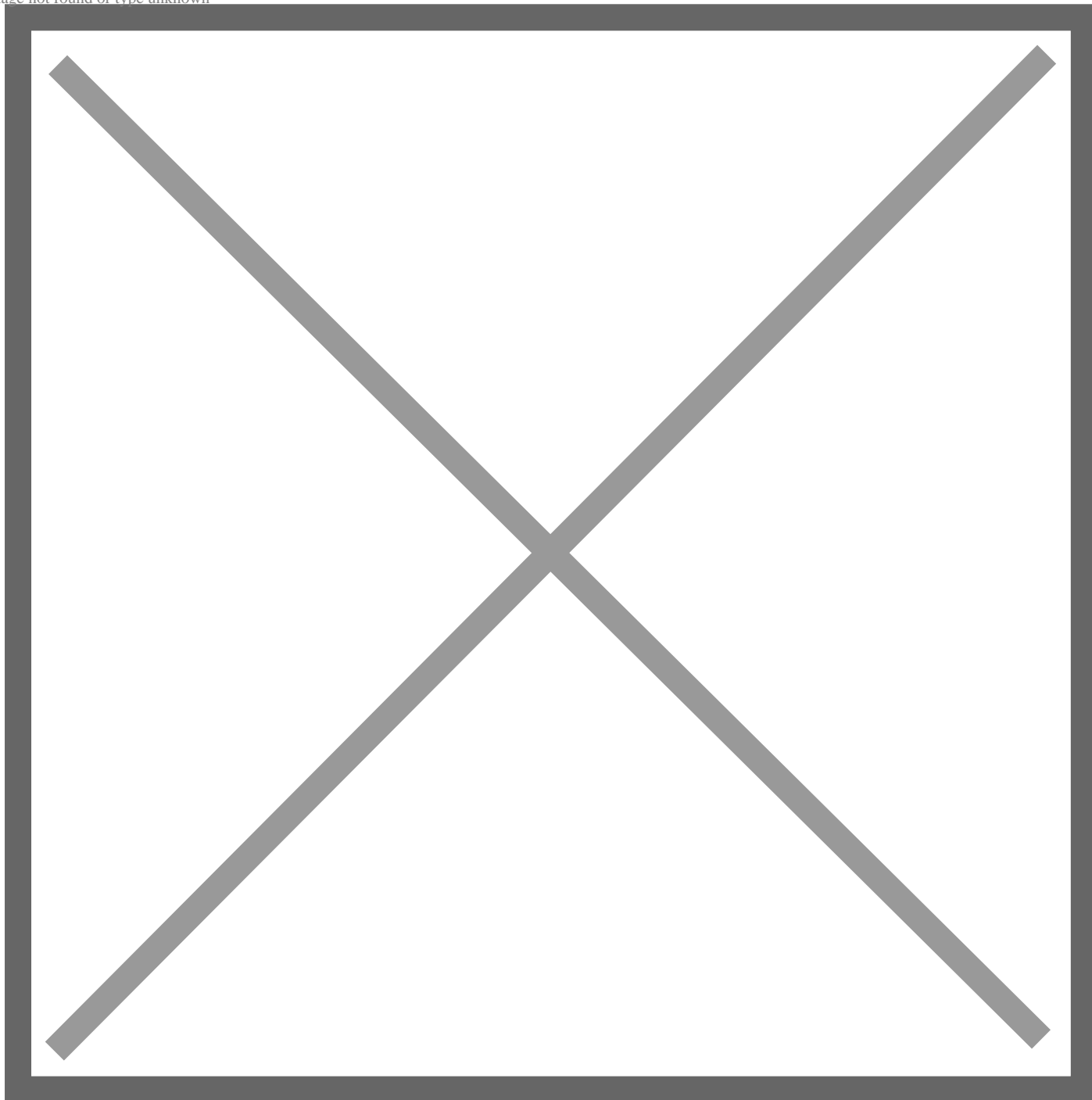


Four Toyota Leaders Recognized Among 100 Leading Women in the North American Auto Industry
