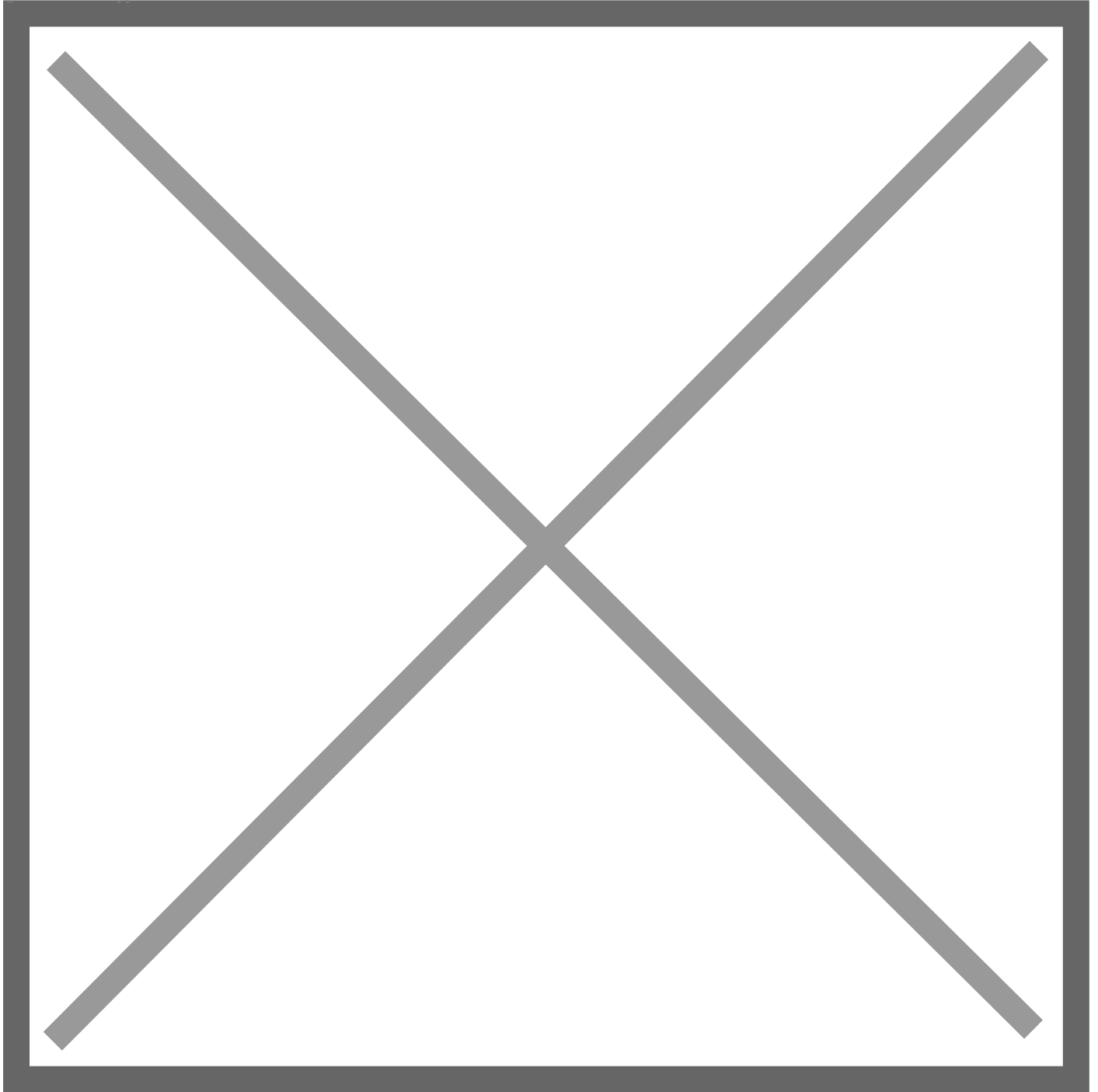
For the 2025 season, Toyota Driver Gio Ruggiero's approach has been to slow down and embrace a peaceful mentality.

### **Maintaining a Competitive Edge**



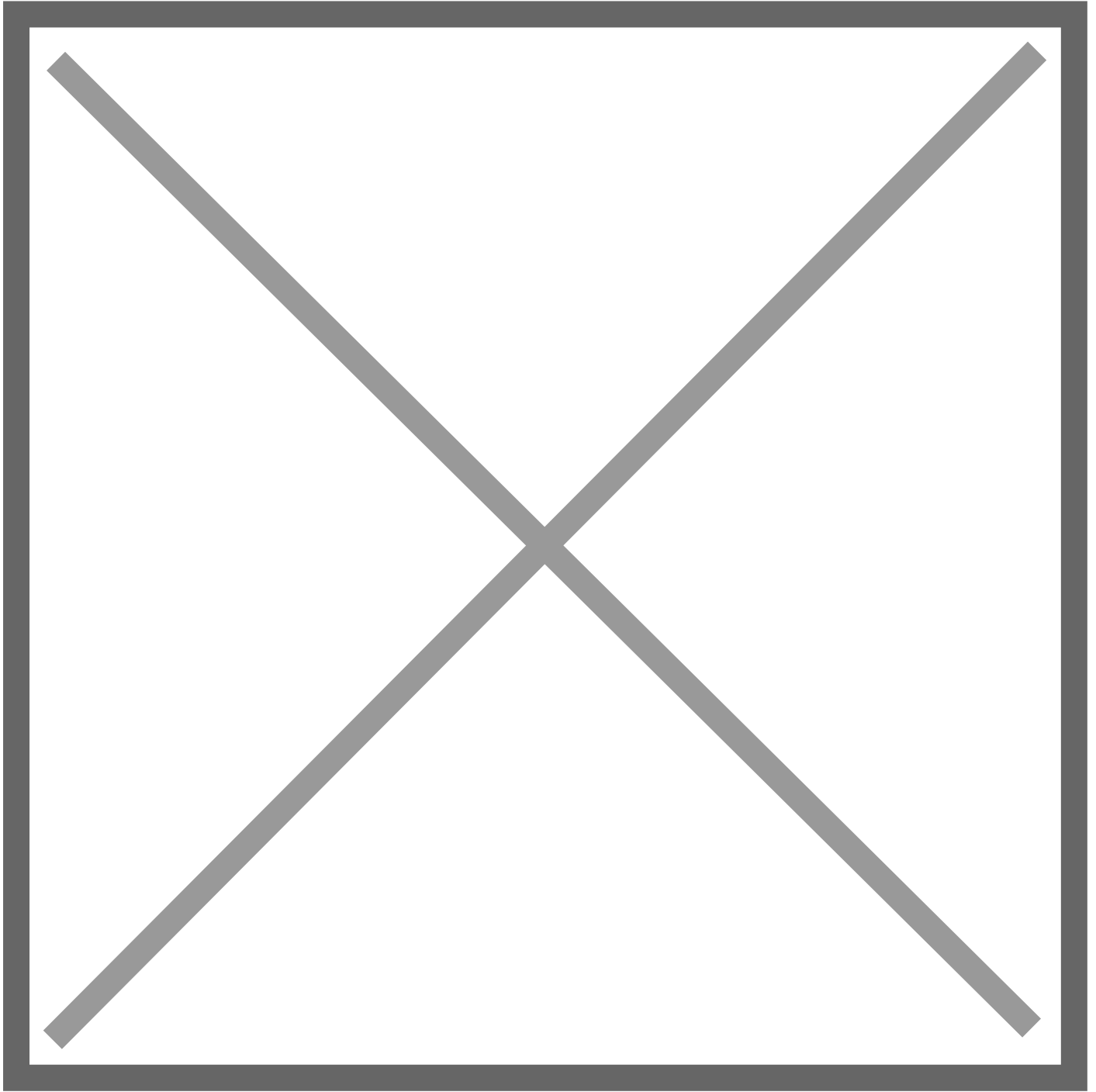
Recognizing his rookie status in the Truck Series, he's been committed to working even harder to stay competitive.

## Races to Remember



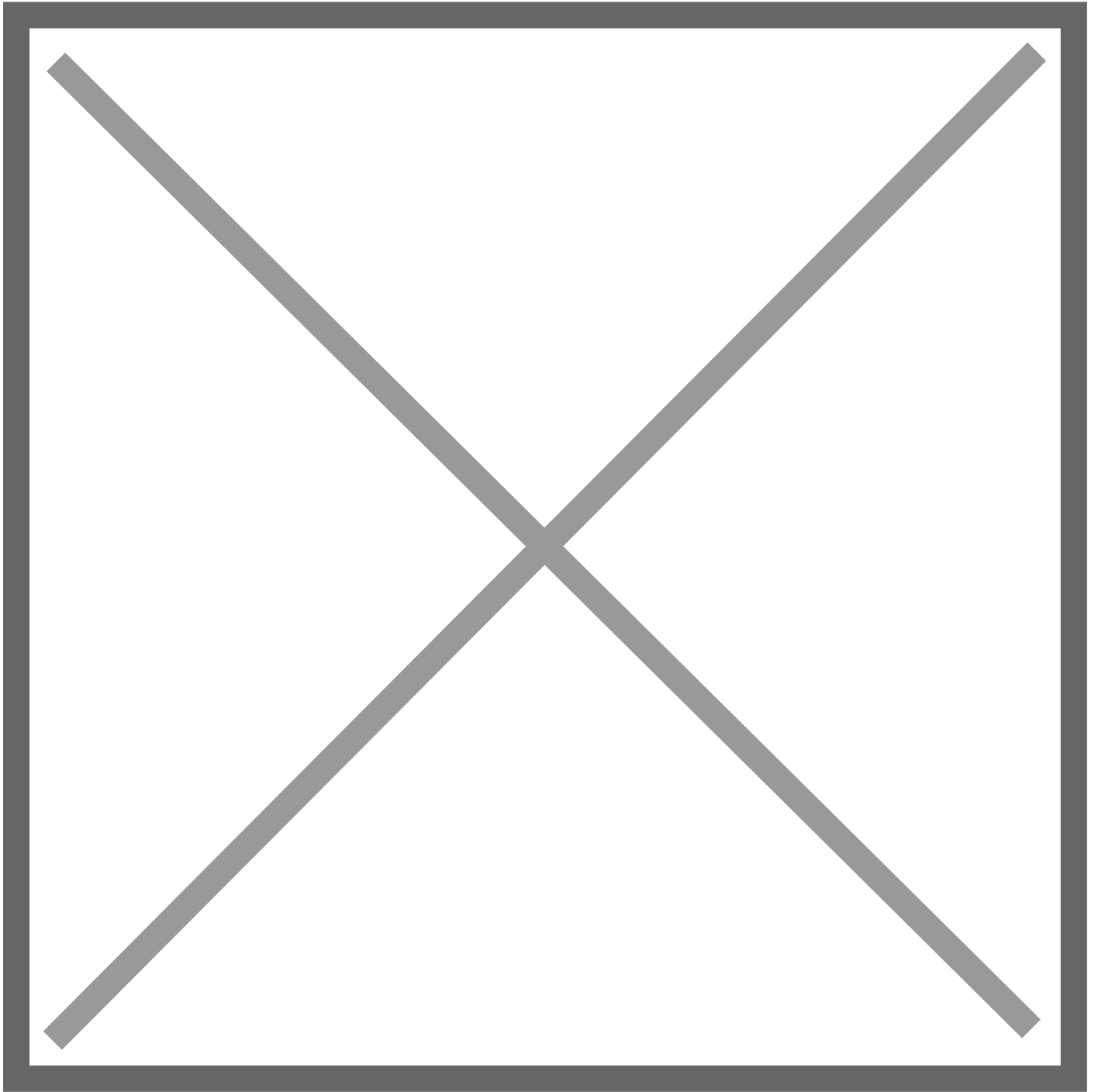
While he may be new to the Truck Series tracks, his love for racing isn't.
