

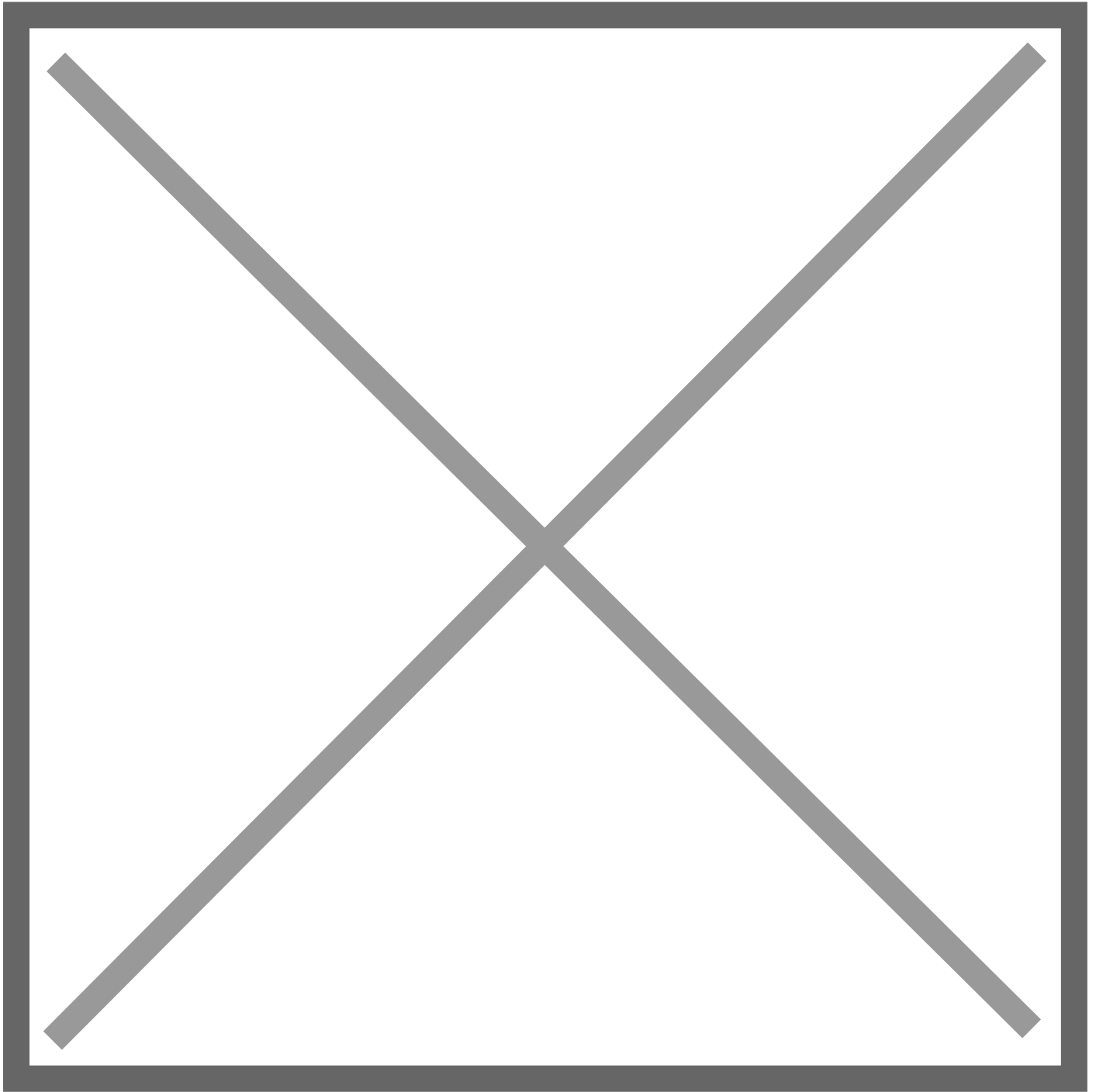
Working with Mom: Toyota Team Members Share Their Stories
