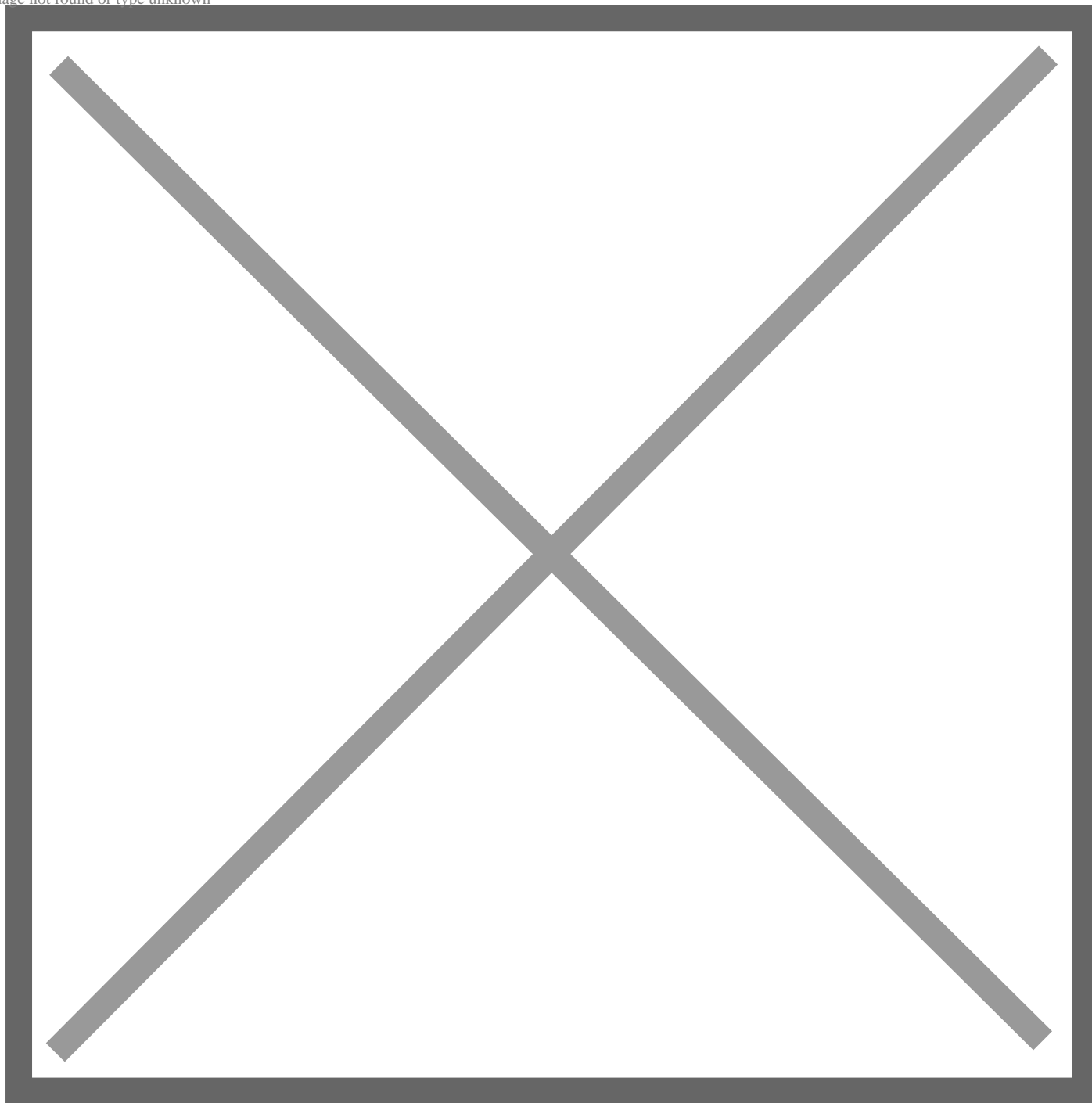


# Toyota Shares Vision for New EV Technologies on ‘Tomorrow’s World Today’ TV Show
