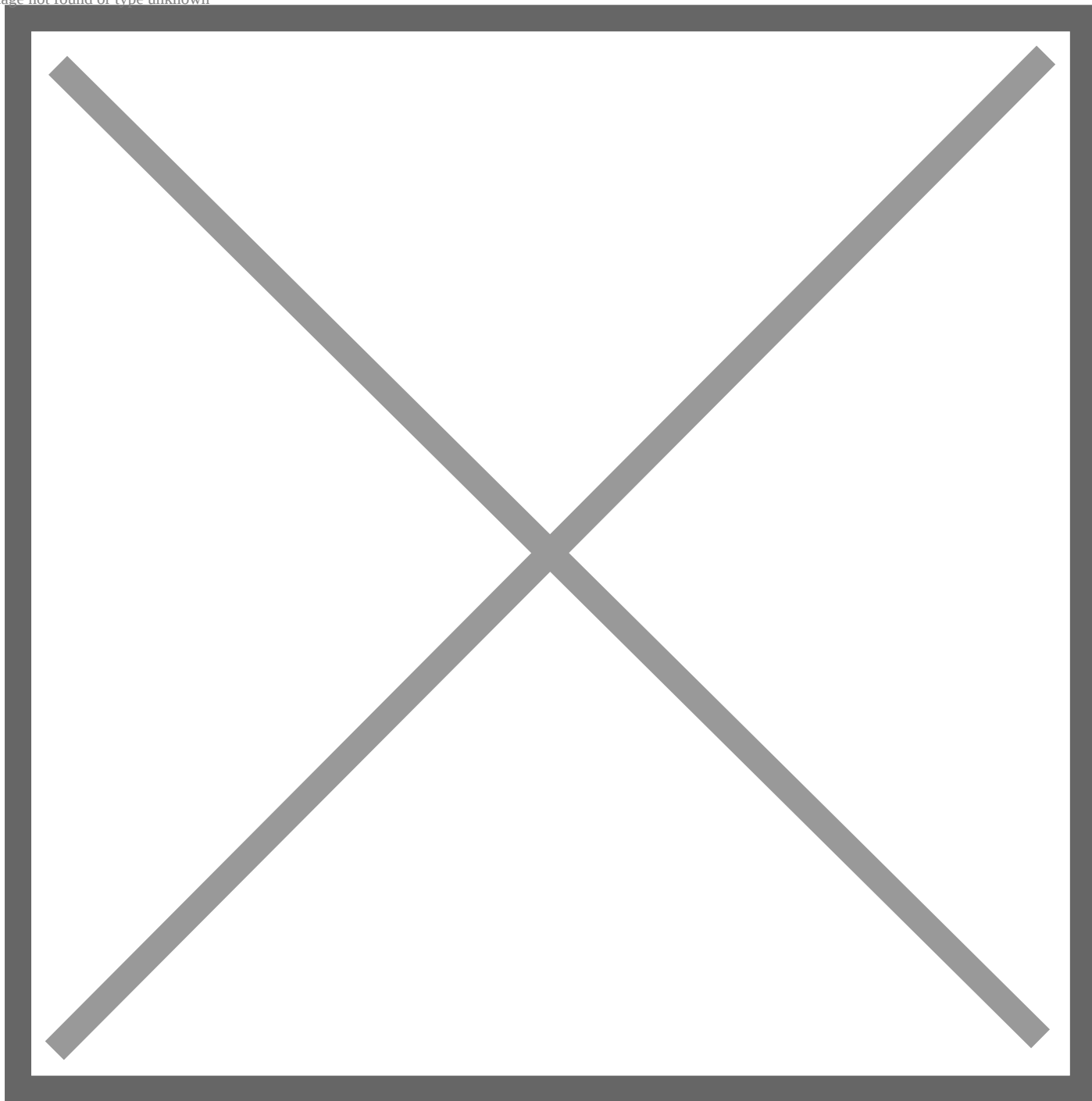


Toyota Motor North America Announces Executive Change

Effective Sept. 8th, **Niki Allen** will join TMNA as chief information officer.
