Company Profile

- Foundation: June 1, 2001, SOP 2003
- Plant site: 334 acres in Huntsville, AL
- Plant size: 1 million square feet
- Investment: \$1.2 billion

Products and 2020 Production Volume

- 537,143 engines produced
- 700,000 capacity
- 4-cylinder (RAV4, Corolla)
- V6 (Tacoma)
- V8 (Sequoia, Tundra)

Investments, Jobs and Production

- 7 major investments (5 building expansions) since groundbreaking in 2001
- The latest \$288 million investment will provide new 4-cylinder and V6 engine lines to expand production capacity by about 35%, increase product flexibility and help better meet demand. This brings the total plant investment to \$1.2 billion.
- The two new production lines will create 450 new jobs, increasing total employment to about 1,800 Toyota supports nearly 10,000 jobs in the state of Alabama.
- Produces 1/3 of all engines built in the U.S and five times as many since starting production.
- Only Toyota plant globally to build 4-cylinder, V6 and V8 engines under one roof.

Environmental Sustainability

- Toyota Alabama is designated as one of two model sustainable plants in North America.
- Zero landfill facility.
- EPA Energy Star Challenge for Industry award (5 consecutive years).
- Toyota North America awards for outstanding energy and water management (13 consecutive years).

Community Involvement

- \$12 million donated to local non profits since 2003.
- \$700,000 donated to local non profits in 2020.
- Toyota Alabama is represented on 20 local non profit boards.

Diverse Workforce

- Our team members represent 18 different counties in Alabama and Tennessee.
- Our team members are local, but they represent 14 countries, 32 U.S. States and speak 20 different languages.
