

Toyota Research Institute Expands Autonomous Vehicle Development Team

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Cambridge, Mass., March 9, 2016 — Toyota Research Institute (TRI) and Jaybridge Robotics announced today that the Jaybridge Robotics software engineering team has joined TRI.
