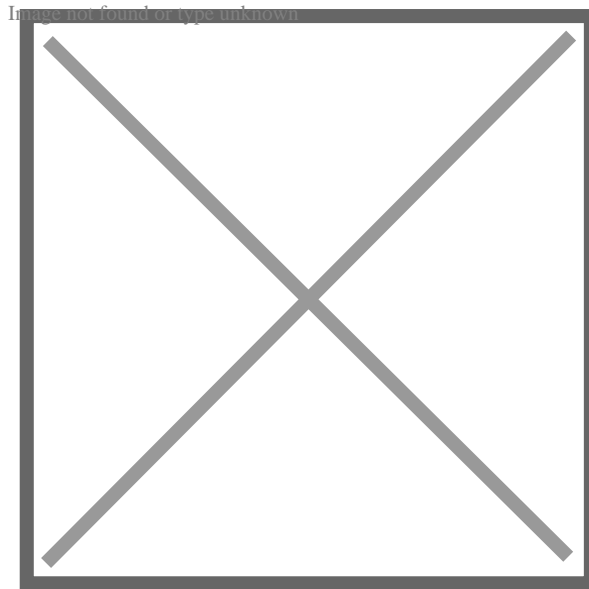


Jacqueline Thomas
