

Toyota Appoints Manager of Texas Government Affairs

WASHINGTON, DC, Oct. 23, 2014 — Toyota announced today the appointment of Tanya Vazquez in a newly created position of Senior Manager of State Government Affairs in Texas as another milestone in the company's plan to build its new North American headquarters in the state. She will be based in Austin, the state capitol.

She also worked on tax issues with the state House Ways and Means Committee. Before her government career, Vazquez worked for several major corporations in the banking and hotel industries.
