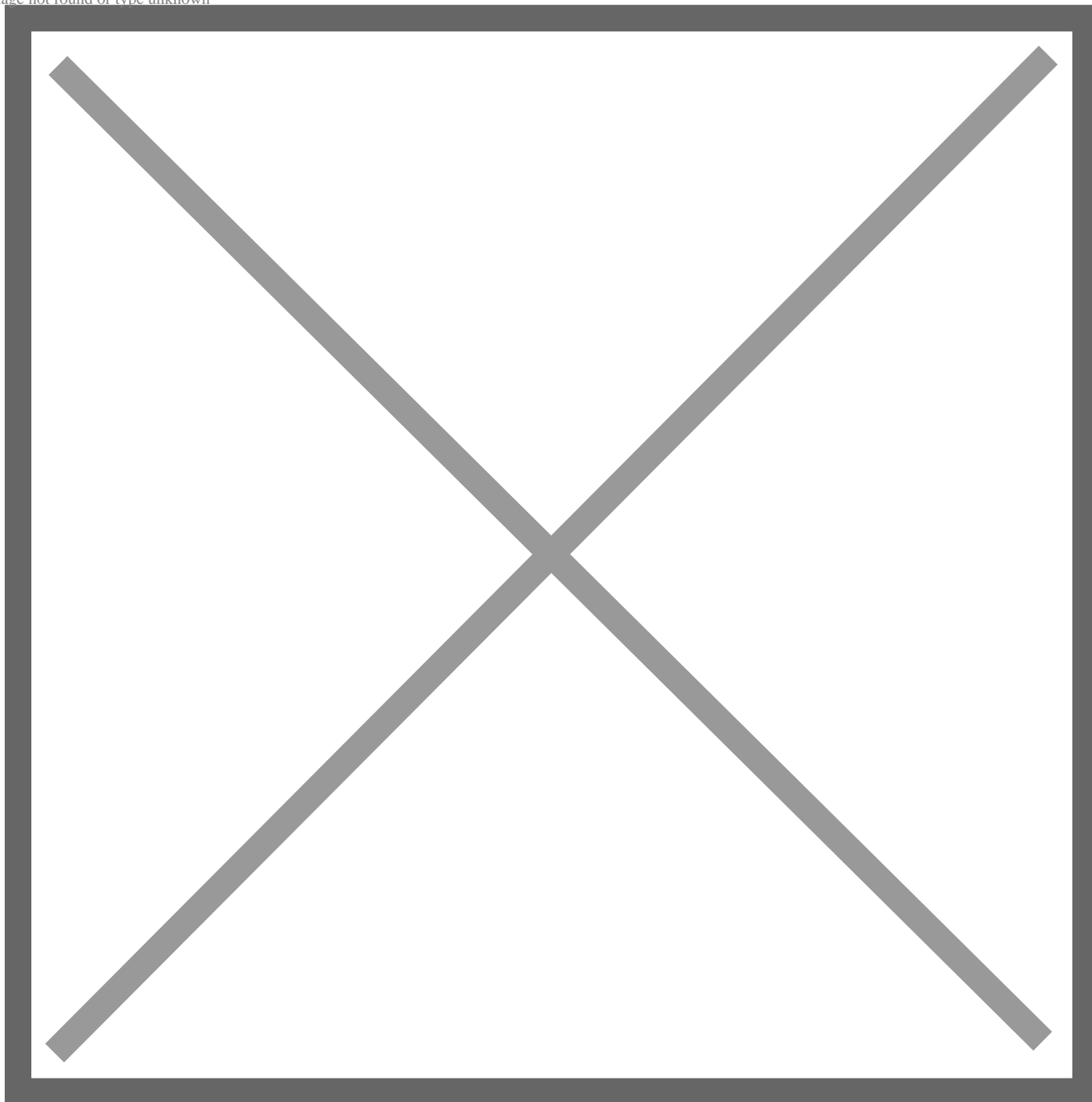


# Scion FR-S Races to the Top
