

# Third Group of 25 Winners Announced in Toyota's 100 Cars for Good Program

TORRANCE, Calif. (August 2, 2012)– Toyota today announced the third group of winners of Toyota's *100 Cars for Good* program, a national philanthropic program that is awarding 100 cars to 100 nonprofits over the course of 100 consecutive days. Winners are selected each day through public voting on Facebook at [www.100carsforgood.com](http://www.100carsforgood.com).

Each day through August 21, five nonprofit organizations will be profiled on the *100 Cars for Good* Facebook page. Registered Facebook users are able to vote once daily for the nonprofit they think can do the most good for the community with a new vehicle. The organization with the most votes at the end of the day wins a new Toyota vehicle. The four runners-up each receive a \$1,000 cash grant from Toyota.
