About Toyota Logistics Services (TLS):	Established in 1976, Toyota Logistics Services (TLS), a subsidiary of Toyota Motor Sales, U.S.A., Inc., manages Toyota, Lexus, and Scion vehicle logistics operations, planning, and administration.
Purpose:	<p>TLS is responsible for processing and distributing import and domestic products sold within the United States.</p> <p>This includes partnerships with eight North American Class I railroads, 12 trucking companies, 10 ocean carriers, and management of approximately 4,200 routes.</p> <p>TLS is also responsible for inbound vehicle logistics for Mexico, and U.S. exports of vehicles produced in North America to 34 countries worldwide.</p> <p>TLS manages Toyota Transport, Toyota's in-house vehicle transportation trucking company, which delivers vehicles in nine Western states.</p>

Operations:	<p>Operations in Arizona, California, Indiana, Kentucky, New Jersey, Oregon, Texas, Florida, and Canada.</p> <p>TLS has 11 Vehicle Distribution Centers (VDCs) across the U.S. and two in Canada, which processed a combined total of 2,265,000 vehicles in 2008.</p>
