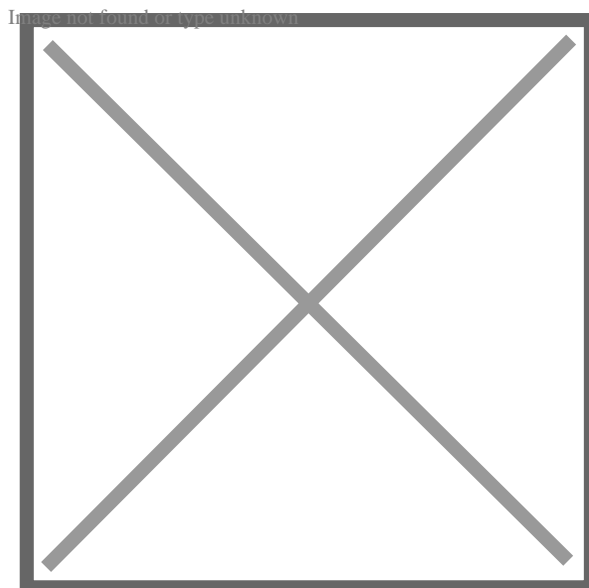


Holly Walters
