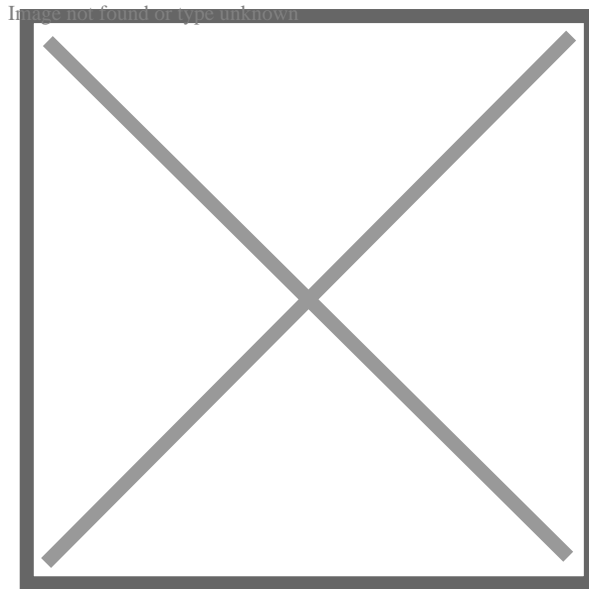


Jason Puckett
