





Toyota bZ4X Concept

experience that is both comfortable and engaging.




2022 Toyota GR 86

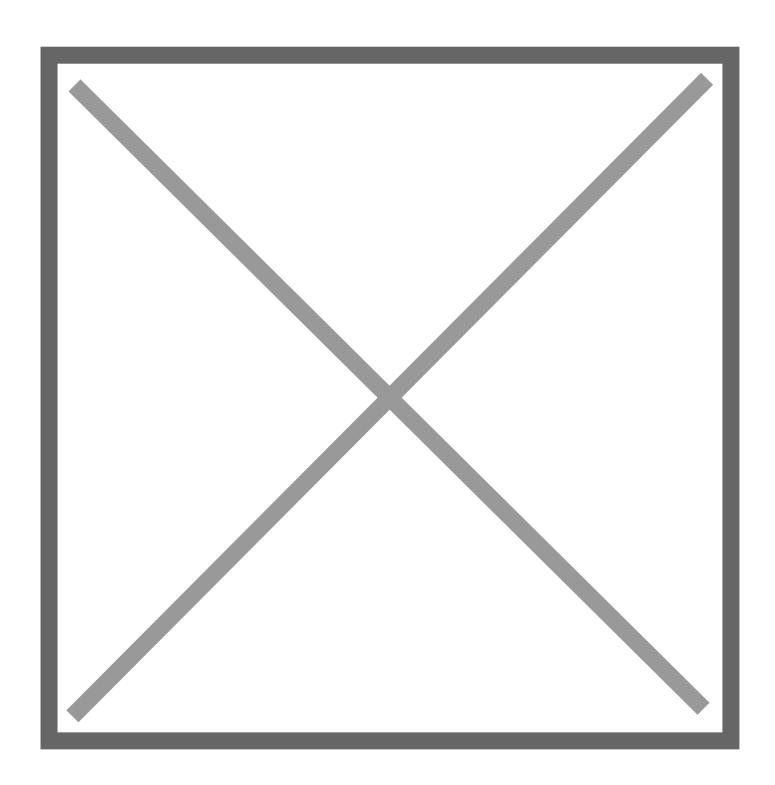


2022 Toyota Tacoma TRD Pro

2022 Toyota Tacoma Trail Edition




2022 Toyota 4Runner TRD Sport



2022 Toyota Prius Nightshade Edition

The Toyota Prius is making a statement for model year 2022 with a new Nightshade special edition. Known for its wind-piercing shape, this Prius brings unexpectedly bold style to the car that made hybrid a household name. Featuring striking black exterior trim, wheels, and badges, it's a Prius that brings a smart, confident addition to the versatile, road-trip ready carline. Available on the FWD and AWD-e grades, the Nightshade edition comes in Midnight Black Metallic, Super White, and Silver Metallic. Its unique exterior features include black headlight accents, mirror caps, door handles, color keyed rear deck spoiler and shark fin antenna. It rides on black 17-inch five-spoke alloy wheels on the FWD, and 15-inch alloy wheels on the AWD-e, paired with black lug nuts.



Teammate Advanced Drive Backgrounder

Teammate® advanced driver assistance technology is a SAE Level 2 system, based on Toyota's Mobility Teammate Concept, that provides two functions: Advanced Drive and Advanced Park. Teammate's Advanced Drive function was designed to partner with and assist the driver to promote safety and convenience while driving on the highway. When activated, Advanced Drive enables automatic steering, acceleration and braking on the highway under active supervision of the driver. It can also perform more complicated driving tasks, including maintaining a set distance between other vehicles, changing lanes, merging and passing or

"overtaking" other vehicles.
