Toyota Motor Manufacturing Kentucky is Toyota's largest vehicle manufacturing plant in the world, capable of producing 550,000 vehicles and more than 600,000 engines annually. Toyota broke ground in Georgetown, Kentucky, in May of 1986, and two years later (May 1988), produced its first Camry. Since then, more than 14

million vehicles have rolled off Toyota's assembly lines in Kentucky, where full-time employment is 9,950. In addition to the Camry Hybrid, America's best-selling car, Toyota Kentucky also manufactures the RAV4 Hybrid, and the Lexus ES 350 and 300h, as well as four-cylinder and V-6 engines. Toyota has invested more than \$154 million in various community philanthropic and educational initiatives since 1986.
