
Toyota Motor Manufacturing, Kentucky (TMMK)

Toyota Motor Manufacturing, Kentucky (TMMK) is Toyota's largest vehicle manufacturing plant in the world, capable of producing 550,000 vehicles and more than 600,000 engines annually. Toyota broke ground in Georgetown, Kentucky, in May of 1986, and two years later (May 1988), produced its first Camry. Since then,

more than 13 million vehicles have rolled off Toyota's assembly lines in Kentucky, where full-time employment is 9,950. In addition to the Camry, America's best-selling car, Toyota Kentucky manufactures the Camry Hybrid and RAV4 Hybrid, as well as four-cylinder and V-6 engines. Toyota has invested more than \$154 million in various philanthropic and educational initiatives since 1986.
