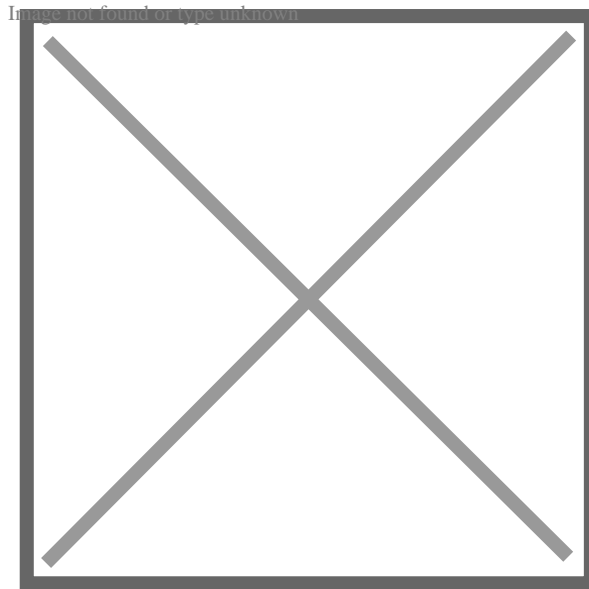


Susann Kazunas



Susann Kazunas is president of Toyota Motor Manufacturing, Texas, Inc. (TMMTX) based in San Antonio, Texas.

She leads all production and administrative functions at the manufacturing facility that assembles the Toyota Tundra and Sequoia.

Previously, Kazunas served as vice president of manufacturing at TMMTX and was responsible for all manufacturing areas including the assembly, weld, stamping, paint, and plastics shops.

Kazunas joined Toyota in 1998 at Toyota Kentucky, working primarily in the stamping and weld shops.
