

Toyota Recalls Certain 2023-2024 Toyota Camry, Camry Hybrid Vehicles

PLANO, Texas (Feb. 21, 2024)—Toyota is conducting a safety recall involving certain Toyota Camry and Camry Hybrid vehicles in the U.S. Approximately 4,000 vehicles are involved in this recall.

The two head restraints on the 60% portion of the rear fold down seats in the involved vehicles may have poor welds on a bracket that can cause the vehicles not to comply with a federal safety standard. This can affect head restraint performance and increase the risk of injury during certain collisions.

For all applicable vehicles, Toyota dealers will replace the 60% rear seat back frame sub-assembly at no cost to customers. Owners of involved vehicles will be notified by late April 2024.
