
Five Things To Know About the All-New 2025 Toyota 4Runner

Striking A Balance

The all-new 4Runner is stylish in every sense of the word and in a class all its own.

Designers blended modern sophistication while retaining 4Runner's authenticity – qualities that loyal customers have grown accustomed to. The second-row tumble seats also help increase the 4Runner's interior versatility and maximize cargo floor usage.

Built To Perform

The 2025 4Runner is built on Toyota's TNGA-F global truck platform, which is shared with Tacoma, Land Cruiser, Tundra and Sequoia. This strong platform utilizes a high-strength boxed, steel-ladder frame and features a multi-link coil rear and double wishbone front suspension.

These features add strength and improve the comfort of the ride for passengers, even those seated in the available third row.

The all-new 4Runner's standard models (SR5, TRD Sport, TRD Sport Premium, TRD Off-Road, TRD Off-Road Premium and Limited grades) boast an i-FORCE turbocharged 2.4-liter four-cylinder engine that produces 278 horsepower and 317 lb-ft. of torque paired to an 8-speed automatic transmission.

That kind of performance lays the groundwork for taking customers on adventurous journeys like heading to campgrounds for the weekend or taking a scenic drive through winding roads to witness the majesty of beautiful groves. The standard i-FORCE engine puts the pedal to the metal for an unforgettable ride.

Pump Up the Power

For adventurers who want an electrified powerful performance, the i-FORCE MAX 2.4-liter turbocharged hybrid powertrain delivers. The all-new 4Runner provides up to 326 net combined horsepower and 465 lb.-ft. of torque and includes an 8-speed automatic transmission and up to 6,000-lb. towing capacity to help customers go harder than before.

This amped-up engine is available on the TRD Off-Road, TRD Off-Road Premium and Limited grades and comes standard on the TRD Pro, Trailhunter and Platinum grades. It's a powerful powertrain offered on 4Runner and makes it the ideal vehicle for navigating rugged terrains and exploring the backcountry.

Ready for Off-Roading

Whether you're driving over unpaved surfaces like dirt, sand, gravel, or other natural elements, the all-new 4Runner Trailhunter grade will help drivers tackle the roads. Built for overlanding, the Trailhunter iteration comes standard with integrated off-road equipment from ARB®, Old Man Emu® and RIGID Industries®.
